2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

MOTION by Chuck Kiester, second by Ron Rutledge, approving the agenda. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY 7-0.**

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – OCTOBER 22, 2015

MOTION by Ron Rutledge, second by Theresa Rejrat, approving the minutes of the October 22, 2015 Code Advisory Committee meeting. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY 7-0.**

4. OLD BUSINESS – CHAIRMAN’S REPORT TO CITY COUNCIL ON CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE II (NUISANCE, LITTER, WEED, PLANT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY CONTROL)

City Clerk Laura Litzan provided information received from Peter Lund, Manager, with the Collier County Public Utilities Department regarding the feasibility of increasing the number of yard waste collection days on Marco Island. Increasing the number of yard waste collection days requires an amendment to the Interlocal/Franchise Agreement Marco Island has with the County, as specified within the County Solid Waste Collections and Disposal Ordinance, with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners and Waste Management.

MOTION by Ray McChesney, second by Theresa Rejrat, to present to City Council the Code Advisory Committee’s recommendation to amend Chapter 18 “Environment,” Article II “Nuisance, Litter, Weed, Plant and Right-of-Way Control,” of the City’s Code of Ordinances under Sec. 18-36 (Prohibited Activities and Conditions) on page CD18:9, number (8) “Placement of Waste at Curb” as follows: “trash put out sunrise the day before pickup and in by sunset the day of trash pickup.” **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY 7-0.**

MOTION by Ron Rutledge, second by Denny Verbance, to recommend to City Council exploring the feasibility of modifying the Interlocal Waste Management agreement with Collier County to increase the frequency of yard waste pickups on Marco Island to two (2) days per week. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY 7-0.**

City Clerk Laura Litzan will schedule Chairman Needles to go before City Council at the February 16, 2016 City Council meeting to present the Code Advisory Committee’s recommendations.

5. NEW BUSINESS (CONTINUED) PUBLIC INPUT REGARDING CODES

Ms. Litzan distributed a daily activity summary for the month of December 2015 prepared by the Code Enforcement Department. She will request that a representative from Code Enforcement attend the next meeting of the Code Advisory Committee to expound on the contents of the summary. She will also ask if a comparison report for 2014 and 2015 is available of code cases heard and fines levied/collected.
