A RESOLUTION APPROVING CHANGES TO THE SPECIAL DUTY RATES FOR THE MARCO ISLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT AS PROVIDED IN EXHIBIT A, ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Florida established the Charter of the City of Marco Island in Chapter 97-367, Laws of Florida; and


WHEREAS, City Council has held a hearing after proper notice, and has considered the special duty changes and other proposed charges;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE MARCO ISLAND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION 1. The special duty rates contained in Exhibit A and the additional charges contained in Exhibit A are hereby ratified and approved by the City Council of Marco Island.


SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption. The foregoing Resolution was adopted this 19th day of May 2014.



Re: Special Duty Review (Drive Out Analysis)

Current status

The current special duty rate is \$36.50 per hour for non-holiday events, while the holiday rate is \$47.75 per hour. These rates have not changed in over three years.

As a comparison, the overtime rate for the most junior officer is \$27.46 per hour and \$38.05 for the most junior sergeant. The average is \$32.75 per hour.

The 2014 drive-out cost for the most junior officer is \$32.81 and \$45.97 for the most junior sergeant. The average is \$39.99 per hour.

The Department formerly charged a percentage (25%) of the contract as an administrative fee to cover all affiliated City expenditures (fuel, vehicles, wear and tear on equipment, etc.). The former City Manager started and stopped this process during his tenure. As an aside, vendors thought this amount was excessive; staff concurs.

Recommendation:

Increase the special duty rate to \$42.50 per hour for non-holiday events, and the holiday rate to \$53.50 per hour. The City will retain a \$5.50 per hour administrative fee; the member will collect the remainder of the fee subject to taxes etc. The administrative fee shall cover the cost of one police vehicle per officer assigned to the detail. In addition, the City will charge a flat \$10.00 processing fee per event.

Emergency Detail Charge - Any detail requested less than 72 hours prior to the commencement of services shall be charged at the rate of \$50.00 per hour for non-holiday events, and the holiday rate of \$60.00 per hour. The City will retain a \$5.50 per hour administrative fee; the member will collect the remainder of the fee subject to taxes etc. The administrative fee shall cover the cost of one police vehicle per officer assigned to the detail.

Additional Charges	
Static, display or additional police vehicle / vessel	\$5.00 per hour
Motorcycle or Beach ATV	\$4.00 per hour
Vessel	\$15.00 per hour
Message Board	\$3.00 per hour + \$20.00 pickup and drop off

Comparison:

Naples P.D \$40.00 w/out vehicle or \$42.00 w/ vehicle, with City retaining \$5.00 - \$7.00
CCSO \$42.50 per hour with City retaining \$6.50
FWCC & FHP No set rate; member sets rate and reimburses State for use of vehicle or boat
