

RESOLUTION 14-09

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING ALLEY PARKING PROHIBITIONS;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances for the City of Marco Island, PART II, Chapter 50 – Traffic and Vehicle, Article II, Stopping Standing and Parking was adopted by the Marco Island City Council ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Marco Island does hereby find the following facts:

- (1) The improper and unregulated parking in alleys is detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Marco Island.
- (2) The maintenance and control of access to buildings, both public and private, for all persons is important to citizens of Marco Island.
- (3) The unobstructed passage of vehicles in alleys is required for emergency vehicle traffic and vital to the citizens of Marco Island.
- (4) The protection of the quality of life and economy of the City of Marco Island, its businesses and its citizens can be accomplished by controlling parking and access to facilities.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Marco Island, has received a properly authorized recommendation from the City of Marco, Island Planning Board, in conjunction with City staff; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Marco Island has determined it is in the best interest of the public to regulate alley obstructions consistent with such recommendations and as hereby set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The following alleys including pavement, improved or unimproved surfaces, swale or any portion of the City road right-of-way are declared no parking zones in accordance with the Code of Ordinances for the City of Marco Island, PART II, Chapter 50, Section 50-37:

1. O'Malley's Alley (North Barfield Drive to East Elkcam Circle)
2. O'Neill's Way (O'Malley's Alley to East Elkcam Circle)
3. Josbergers Way (Hartley Avenue to Tallwood Street)
4. Unnamed alley (or any future named alley) that runs between Park Avenue to West Elkcam Circle to Veterans Memorial Park
5. Unnamed alley (or any future named alley) that runs between San Marco Road to North Barfield Drive to San Marco Road


Section 2. Alleys and all portions of the right of ways designated by this Resolution shall be considered a tow away zone as designated in the Code of Ordinances for the City of Marco Island, PART II, Chapter 50, Section 50-36 and 50-44.

Section 3. Appropriate signage giving notice of such parking prohibitions and tow away zones will be erected in the alleys designated in this Resolution in accordance with in the Code of Ordinances for the City of Marco Island, PART II, Chapter 50, Section 50-36.

Section 4. Due to the public safety concerns, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




