

**RESOLUTION 14-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE COLLIER COUNTY GOVERNMENT BEACH RENOURISHMENT PROJECT, MARCO ISLAND NORTH BEACH RE-GRADE, WITHIN THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND INCORPORATED LIMITS PURSUANT TO AND FULLY FUNDED BY COLLIER COUNTY'S TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marco Island, Florida finds that the north beach area of Marco Island, between Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Beach Monuments R-136 to R-143, since 1999 when Sand Dollar Island connected to the main beach, has experienced accreted sands and widening of the beach, which in turn has created poor drainage conditions, ponding of water and topography issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the north beach area's diminished recreational use, unsuitable habitat for nesting shorebirds and sea turtles and unsightly conditions with possible healthy conditions due to the drainage issues will be remedied with renourishment that will increase the beach elevation and improve the slope to the Gulf of Mexico; and

**WHEREAS**, the City supports Collier County Governments to seek FDEP permits for construction of the Marco Island North Beach Re-Grade.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:


**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The Marco Island North Beach Re-Grade Project proposed and funded by Collier County Government is a viable solution to the poor drainage and topography issues


**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


