

RESOLUTION 14-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH QUALITY ENTERPRISES, USA FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE COLLIER BOULEVARD BRIDGE OVER SMOKEHOUSE BAY REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$8,625,327.66; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2014, the City of Marco Island (the "City") accepted the lowest responsible bid for the construction of the Collier Boulevard Bridge over the Smokehouse Bay Replacement Project, Contract 14-002, (the "Project") from Quality Enterprises, USA (the Contractor); and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2014, the City Council directed City staff to implement bid alternate No. 3 for Contract No. 14-002 to expedite bridge completion; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor established the following criteria for the project:

1. If given a notice to proceed to order materials immediately, the earliest actual start date for the construction work would be July 15, 2014, with substantial completion by July 1, 2015. Final completion would be as stipulated in the contract bid documents thirty days after or August 1, 2015.
2. Working hours will be between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m., six days a week (no Sunday work), with pile driving limited to daylight hours.
3. Liquidated damages to be assessed if the construction exceeds the proposed contract schedule without any authorized delays, would be at a value of twice the rate indicated in the bid documents or \$6,114.00 per day.
4. The schedule does not account for delays due to unforeseen site conditions or other factors which could affect the scheduled completion date. This includes any additional time allowed for weather delays.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

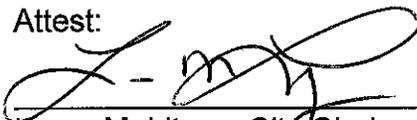
Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The contract between the City and the Contractor for the construction of the project in an amount not to exceed \$8,625,327.66, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Contract and/or Contract Change Order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

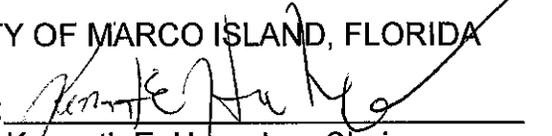

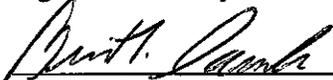
