

RESOLUTION 14-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN COLLIER COUNTY AND THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND TO PROVIDE FDOT PROCURED UNINTERRUPTED POWER SUPPLY EQUIPMENT FOR INSTALLATION AT TRAFFIC SIGNALS WITHIN THE CITY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on April 2nd, 2014, the County entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) wherein FDOT agreed to supply the County with Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) equipment for traffic signal in Collier County as part of FDOT's five year work program; and

WHEREAS, as part of the County's responsibilities under the MOA it was to enter into separate MOA's with the City of Marco Island and act as a conduit to directly provide the City with UPS equipment supplied by FDOT for their installation and future maintenance at various traffic signal locations; and

WHEREAS, the City and County wish to enter into this Interlocal Agreement (Agreement) to memorialize the County's delivery of the UPS equipment and the City's duty to install and maintain the UPS equipment following delivery by the County; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County have determined and mutually agree that it is mutually advantageous and in the best interest of the public to consummate this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.


Section 2. This Agreement and the terms and provisions hereof shall be effective as of the date this Agreement is executed by both parties and shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, personal representatives, successors, successor trustees, and/or assignees, wherever the contest so requires or admits and shall terminate upon the completion of services and responsibilities mutually performed by the City and the County.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




