

RESOLUTION 14-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF POLICE SERVICE IMPACT FEES

WHEREAS, the safety, health and welfare of residents, businesses and visitors, is a primary responsibility of the City of Marco Island.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for enhanced services to the beaches, park, schools, residential and commercial areas, the Marco Island Police Department created a Community Service Officer Program utilizing currently authorized operating funds.

WHEREAS, capital expenditures are required to facilitate the equipment start-up costs of the Community Service Officer Program.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island established its Police Service Impact Fees in City of Marco Island Ordinance 02-18.

WHEREAS, impact fees are a method of shifting a portion or the entire burden of the cost of new programs or infrastructure, to accommodate new development away from the community at large - to new development itself. As such the start-up equipment capital costs of the Community Service officer program would be an authorized expenditure of impact fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the Marco Island Police Department, through the City Manager, to expend Police Service impact fees for an amount not to exceed \$92,311.60 to defer the capital start-up costs associated with the Community Service Officer Program. The City Manager is authorized to execute the required purchases and expend impact fee funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




