

RESOLUTION 15- 43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR RESOLUTION REQUESTS SUPPORTING CITIZEN INITIATIVES.

WHEREAS, Article VI of the Marco Island City Charter establishes requirements for Initiatives and Referendums; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.01 of the City Charter states that "ten percent (10%) of the qualified electors of the City shall have the power to petition the Council or propose an *ordinance* (emphasis added) or to require reconsideration of an *adopted ordinance*...; and


WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council wishes to establish minimal requirements for citizens petitioning Council for a resolution in support of their initiative.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

- Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- Section 2.** Requests for resolutions supporting citizen initiatives require one percent (1%) of the qualified electors of the City to sign a petition asking the City Council to place the proposed resolution on a future agenda for consideration. City Council will not be obligated to adopt any resolution proposed as a citizen initiative.
- Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


