

RESOLUTION 15-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE RANKING AND RECOMMENDATION FOR THE SELECTION OF SHENONDOAH CONSTRUCTION TO CLEAN, INSPECT AND REPAIR THE CITY'S WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, inspection programs are required to determine current sewer conditions and to aid in planning a maintenance strategy; and

WHEREAS, the sewer cleaning, inspection and repairs to the sewer lines are essential to maintaining a properly functioning collection system; and

WHEREAS, these activities will preserve the City's investment in its wastewater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island published a request for bid from experienced contractors; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2015 the City received three (3) responses which were subsequently received and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the ranking of firms and contracting with the top ranked firm, Shenondoah Construction for these services is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council accepts the bids received and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Contract with the Contractor, the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount not to exceed \$136,029.50, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney. The City Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


