

RESOLUTION 15-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, AFFIRMING THE SELECTION OF TV DIVERSIFIED TO REPAIR AREAS OF THE CITY'S WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM, LINE MANHOLES WHERE THE CONCRETE SUBSTRATE HAS BEEN COMPROMISED BY DEBRIS, HYDROGEN SULFIDE AND AGE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the evaluation of the City's manholes reveal concrete structural damage caused by age and hydrogen sulfide gas that require rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the installation of structural liners in the City's wastewater collection system are essential to maintain a properly functioning collection system; and

WHEREAS, these activities will preserve the City's investment in its wastewater infrastructure and prolong the structural integrity of the manholes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Marco Island procurement regulations, the City of Marco Island published a Request For Bids for this project; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2015, the City received four (4) responses which were subsequently reviewed and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, THE City Council finds that the ranking of the firms and contracting with the top ranked firm TV Diversified for these services is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:


SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Council accepts the Bids received and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with TV Diversified for the services outlined in the contract, as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney in the amount not to exceed \$60,170.00. The City Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


