

RESOLUTION 15-65

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF THE INSTALLATION OF SPRAY FOAM INSULATION FOR THE SWTP WAREHOUSE BY NEGOTIATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-260 OF THE CITY'S PURCHASING ORDINANCE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$59,857 USING EXISTING UTILITY CARRYOVER FUNDING.

WHEREAS, The City of Marco Island solicited and received three competitive quotes for the warehouse insulation in February, 2015, and each quote exceeded \$25,000 thereby requiring a public bid; and

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2015, the City of Marco Island (City) published a public invitation to bid for the insulation of the South Water Treatment Plant (SWTP) warehouse located at 415 Lily Ct.; and

WHEREAS, no bids were received prior to the bid opening deadline of 2:00 pm on August 13, 2015; and

WHEREAS, section 2-260 of the City's purchasing ordinance allows City Council to authorize the City to purchase by negotiation in the absence of bids; and

WHEREAS, available funding has been identified from carryover funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract for the aforementioned insulation in the amount not to exceed \$59,857, together with such non-material changes, as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved by the City Attorney.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon City Council approval.




