

Trash Collection

Trash collection services are automated using roll out carts. The cart with the green lid is for trash. Trash will be collected twice a week. Excess trash should be placed curbside in tightly sealed heavy duty plastic bags.



Recycling Collection

Recycling collection services are automated using roll out carts. The cart with the yellow lid is strictly for recyclables. Recycling will be collected once a week on the same day as bulky items and yard waste.

Do not overfill carts. Do not place yard waste or recyclables in your trash cart.

Trash and Recycling Roll Cart Sizes

Trash carts are available in 96, 64, and 48 gallon sizes. Recycling carts are available in 64 and 48 gallon sizes. You may request a one-time change in the size of your cart.

Curbside Placement

Trash and recycling carts, yard waste and bulky items must be placed curbside prior to 6:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day. Materials may be placed curbside after 6:00 p.m. the evening before the scheduled collection day. Place containers and materials within three feet of the curb and at least four feet from other obstacles. Cart lids must be fully closed to prevent rain intrusion. Empty carts, personal containers, and any items not collected or tagged as non-compliant must be removed from the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. the morning after scheduled collection.

Ownership of Trash and Recycling Carts

Carts are owned by the hauler or the County, and may only be removed from the customer's property by the hauler or the County. An extra recycling cart may be provided by the County at no cost. Extra trash carts may be purchased.

Damaged or Missing Trash and Recycling Carts

Trash and recycling carts are repaired or replaced free of charge. If your trash or recycling cart is missing, stolen, needs replacement or repair, please call (239) 252-2380. Please make sure to have the cart size (in gallons) when calling for a repair or replacement. The cart size is embossed on the top of the lid. **If a trash or recycling cart must be replaced because of the customer's negligence, the customer may be charged the replacement price for the cart, plus a delivery fee.**



Bulky Item Collection

Bulky items are items too large or heavy to fit in your green trash cart. Bulky items may be placed curbside for free collection on your recycling day. **You must call (239) 252-2380 at least 48-hours before your recycling collection day to schedule a bulky item pick up.** Multiple bulky items may result in a charge. Bulky items placed curbside without a scheduled collection may result in a fine.

White Goods Collection

To prevent the accidental entrapment of children, remove all doors from appliances prior to placing them curbside for collection.



Stoves, refrigerators, clothes washers, dishwashers, microwave ovens and other household appliances may be placed curbside for free collection on your recycling day. **You must call (239) 252-2380 at least 48-hours before your recycling collection day to schedule a pick up.** White goods placed curbside without a scheduled collection may result in a fine.

Electronics Collection

Unwanted electronic equipment (computers, printers, televisions, telephones, stereos, etc.) may be placed curbside for free collection on your recycling day. **You must call (239) 252-2380 at least 48-hours before your recycling collection day to schedule a pick up.** Electronics placed curbside without a scheduled collection may result in a fine.



Tires and Batteries

Each month, up to four standard vehicle tires with an outer diameter up to 33 inches, with or without rims, and up to two vehicle batteries may be placed curbside for free collection on your recycling day. **You must call (239) 252-2380 at least 48-hours before your recycling collection day to schedule a pick up.** Tires and batteries placed curbside without a scheduled collection may result in a fine.



Yard Waste

Yard waste is collected curbside on your recycling collection day.

To prepare your yard waste for collection—

Bundle — bundles must weigh less than 50 pounds, be no longer than 4 feet in length, and have no branches larger than 4 inches in diameter, and be securely tied with twine.

Container — 32 gallon personal containers may be used. Containers must weigh less than 50 pounds when filled and yard waste may not extend more than 12 inches over the top of the container.

Bag — Use only paper yard waste or paper grocery bags. Plastic bags are not accepted as a method of preparing leaves, grass and other yard trimmings for collection.

Yard waste will not be collected if it is not properly prepared. Please limit yard waste to a combination of no more than 10 bundles, paper bags, or personal containers to be collected at one time.

Construction & Demolition Materials (C&D)

C&D debris generated on a residential property by a licensed builder or contractor must be removed by the homeowner, the builder or contractor. Discarded materials from small household repairs, renovations, or projects may be placed in the green trash cart. C&D debris may NOT be placed curbside outside of your trash cart.

Holiday Collection Schedule

There are three holidays each year when there is no collection of any kind:

- Fourth of July
- Thanksgiving
- Christmas Day.

There is no make-up day. If your collection falls on one of these holidays, your trash/recycling/yard waste will be collected on your next regularly scheduled collection day.





HAZARDOUS PRODUCTS ARE NOT COLLECTED CURBSIDE

Gasoline, antifreeze, used oil, paints, pesticides, and other hazardous materials, including fluorescent bulbs and unused or outdated pharmaceuticals and biomedical sharps, are not collected curbside. These items should be taken to a **Collier County Recycling Drop-off Center**. See the back panel for locations and hours of operation.

Accepted Recyclables

- Newspapers
- Phone books
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Junk mail
- Paper bags
- Cardboard
- Cereal & juice boxes
- Aluminum cans
- Steel cans
- Tin cans
- All plastics with the chasing arrows symbol numbered 1-7
- Clear glass
- Brown glass
- Green glass
- Styrofoam trays, and egg cartons

Remove all food residue from items before placing them in the recycling cart. **The cart lid must be closed fully to prevent rain intrusion.** Excess recycling should be placed curbside in **clear plastic** bags. Flatten and bundle cardboard into pieces measuring 3'x3' or less in size. If you consistently have excess recycling, an additional recycling cart may be provided by the County at no cost. **Do not overfill carts. Do not place yard waste or other materials in your recycling cart.**
