

RESOLUTION 16-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THREE YEAR CONTRACT EXTENSIONS WITH A NUMBER OF ENGINEERING FIRMS TO ASSIST THE CITY WITH VARIOUS CIVIL ENGINEERING PROJECTS (RFQ 13-001); ADDING NEW COMPANIES TO THE LIST OF ENGINEERING FIRMS TO ASSIST THE CITY WITH VARIOUS WATER/WASTEWATER TREATMENT AND HYDROLOGY RELATED ENGINEERING PROJECTS (RFQ 14-007); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Florida Statutes, Section 287.055, Consultants Competitive Negotiations Act, the City of Marco Island (the "City") published a request for qualifications RFQ 13-001 from Florida certified, licensed, and experienced engineering firms to provide civil engineering services and RFQ 14-007 to provide water/wastewater treatment and hydrology engineering services for a various City projects; and

WHEREAS, contracts in conjunction with RFQ 13-001 have been awarded for a three (3) year term with a possibility of one (1) additional three (3) year extension; and civil engineering library as outlined in the Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, will be active till March 5, 2019 with any possible firm additions; and

WHEREAS, all City of Marco engineering RFQ solicitations are open for qualified firms to join the library at any time; and Kadrmās, Lee & Jackson, Inc., Q. Grady Minor & Associates, P.A., and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. have expressed their desire to be added to the existing RFQ 14-007 for water/wastewater treatment and hydrology engineering library as outlined in the Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, funding for various engineering projects under these contracts is included in the approved operating department budgets or as an authorized capital improvement projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.


