

**RESOLUTION 16-20**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BID AND APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH ELI CONTRACTING, INC., FOR THE LANDMARK STREET BIKE LANE PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$585,547.62; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on January 17, 2016, the City of Marco Island (the "City") published an Invitation to Bid for the Landmark Street Bike Lane Project (FDOT/LAP), Contract No. 16-002, (the Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, on February 25, 2016, three (3) bids were received, with the lowest bid submitted by Eli Contracting, Inc., (the "Contractor") and City staff subsequently reviewed and determined that the low bid was complete and the bidder was responsive and responsible; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds that accepting the low bid and entering into a contract with the Contractor is in the best interest of the City.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The contract between the City and the Contractor for the construction of the Project in an amount not to exceed \$585,547.62, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Contract and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


