

RESOLUTION 16-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF MOBILE RADIOS FOR THE CITY'S FIRE RESCUE APPARATUS IN ACCORDANCE WITH COLLIER COUNTY CONTRACT #15-6409 WITH COMMUNICATIONS INTERNATIONAL INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$94,845.80; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the United States Federal Government has mandated that all public safety agencies must comply with the P25 phase 2 radio equipment standards; and

WHEREAS, On April 14, 2015 the Collier County Board of County Commissioners approved Contract #15-6409 with Communications International Inc., for the implementation of the P25 phase 2 radio system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island's Fire Rescue Department's current mobile radio equipment is twenty-years (20) old, is non-P25 phase 2 compliant and no longer is supported by the manufacturer; and

WHEREAS, the Collier County Contract #15-6409 with Communications International Inc., includes mobile radio packages with a discount that exceeds the standard twenty-five percent (25%) State of Florida contract discount and provides for a five (5) year warranty; and

WHEREAS, available funding has been identified from the City's Capital Funds Account; and

WHEREAS, City Council does hereby find that entering into this Agreement is in the best interest of the City of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

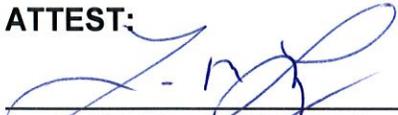
Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Agreement for the purchase and installation of mobile radios in accordance with Collier County Contract #15-6409 in an amount not to exceed \$94,845.80, together with such non-material changes, as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved by the City Attorney. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon City Council approval.

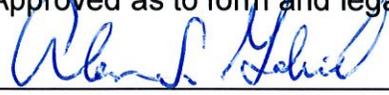
