

RESOLUTION 16-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A VACUUM STYLE TANKER TRAILER FROM ENGINE & ACCESSORY, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$80,000.00 FOR THE CITY'S WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island's Water and Sewer Department maintains the City's wastewater collection, drinking water distribution and reclaimed water distribution systems; and

WHEREAS, the Water and Sewer Department requires a tanker trail for the transference of water/wastewater when repairing water/sewer/reuse mains, lift station, and cleanups from sanitary sewer overflows; and

WHEREAS, the Water and Sewer Department requires a tanker trail for the transference of bio-solids from the Marco Shores Wastewater Treatment Plant to the Marco Island Reclaimed Water Production Facility; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the Tanker Trailer is specially designed to meet the requirements of transferring water, wastewater and bio-solids, which will help the Water and Sewer Department operate in a safer, more efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island ("City") published a public invitation to bid the purchase of the Tanker Trailer; and

WHEREAS, the City reviewed the bid submittal and determined that Engine & Accessory, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, City Council does hereby find that the approval of this Resolution is in the best interest of the City of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Marco Island accepts and approves the low bid proposal from Engine & Accessory, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00,

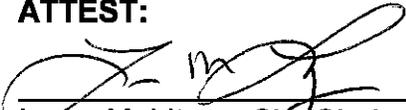
together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager, and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

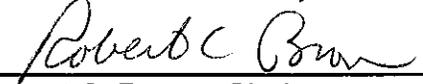
