

RESOLUTION 16-65

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 15-62 TO INCREASE THE OWNER'S CONTINGENCY FROM \$200,000 TO \$400,000 IN THE CITY'S CONTRACT WITH FLORIDA DESIGN CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR A REVISED TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,334,000; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island (City) executed a construction contract (Contract #15-024) with Florida Design Contractors, Inc. (the "Contractor") for a total contract amount of \$5,134,000, which includes a \$200,000 owner's contingency; and

WHEREAS, the construction project is presently under construction; and

WHEREAS, the awarded owner's contingency has been expended; and

WHEREAS, additional contingency funds are needed to complete the construction; and

WHEREAS, City Council does hereby find that the approval of this Resolution is in the best interest of the City of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Marco Island hereby amends Resolution 15-62 to increase the Owner's contingency in the City's contract with Florida Design Contractor's Inc. by \$200,000, which results in a revised contract amount of \$5,334,000.

Section 3. The appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary to carry out the aims of this Resolution, including executing any necessary amendments to the contract with the Contractor.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




