

RESOLUTION 16-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, AFFIRMING THE SELECTION OF SANDERS LABORATORIES FOR A THREE (3) YEAR CONTRACT WITH AN OPTION FOR ONE THREE YEAR RENEWAL FOR LABORATORY SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island, Florida, ("City") owns, operates and maintains drinking water, wastewater and reuse utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida requires various testing parameters to be performed and documented by a State certified laboratory to ensure compliance within regulatory standards for said drinking water, wastewater and reuse systems; and

WHEREAS, the City does not have a State certified laboratory facility to perform the required testing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Marco Island's procurement regulations, the City of Marco Island published a Request For Bids for these services; and

WHEREAS, Sanders Laboratories is the lowest responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds that accepting the low bid and entering into a contract with Sanders Laboratories is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

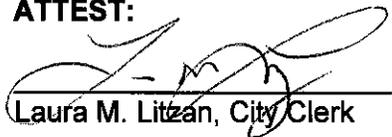
SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Council accepts the bid proposal and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Sanders Laboratories for the services outlined in the bid proposal, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney. The City Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

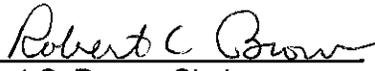
