RESOLUTION 10-01

A RESOLUTION APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION FOR FUNDING TO COLLIER COUNTY FOR POTENTIAL U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FUNDING IN 2010-2011; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island and Collier County government have agreed to participate in a joint Urban County Agreement for Community Development Block Grant funds, and

WHEREAS, Collier County has requested that applications for available FY 2009-2010 CDBG funding be submitted by December 31, 2009, and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the City of Marco Island to provide sidewalks for the safety of all pedestrians and motorists, and

WHEREAS, streetlights have not been constructed in portions of Marco Highlands Subdivision including Marco Lake Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, correct and incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Request for Funding. The City desires to request \$75,000.00 in Community Development Block Grant funding to implement the eligible street light installation activities in Marco Highlands Subdivision to include the installation of twelve (12) streetlights adjacent to Marco Lake Drive depending on eligibility, in the Marco Highlands Subdivision.


SECTION 3. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign and execute an application for the proposed project funding entitled "Request for Proposals, Fiscal Year 2010/2011" as provided by the Collier County Operations Support and Housing Department, Housing and Grants Section.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




