A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND GRATITUDE TO COLLIER COUNTY FOR HURRICANE WILMA RECOVERY ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, Hurricane Wilma, a Category 3 storm, struck Marco Island during the early morning hours of October 24, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the hurricane caused extensive damage to much of our island community; and

WHEREAS, the Collier County Commission and its staff demonstrated exceptional leadership in the planning, operation, and execution of its Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, Collier County planned and managed countywide storm debris removal, including significant storm debris on Marco Island; and

WHEREAS, Collier County Commissioners, County Manager James Mudd, Utilities Director Jim DeLony, and Solid Waste Director Dan Rodriguez understood that Marco Island had extensive damage and recognized Marco Island as a priority for debris collection; and

WHEREAS, Collier County immediately directed equipment and personnel to Marco Island as soon as it became available and kept those assets on Marco Island during the cleanup process.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marco Island City Council in Council duly assembled, that Collier County be recognized and thanked for its excellent response to Hurricane Wilma and for their assistance to the people of Marco Island.
