**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT STATE
REGULATION OF THE USE OF CELLULAR
TELEPHONES WHILE DRIVING**

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 316.0075 expressly preempts regulation of cellular telephone use by motor vehicle drivers to the State; and

WHEREAS, traffic crashes are a leading cause of injury and death in Florida; and

WHEREAS, the use of cellular telephones and other distracting activities while driving have been found to contribute to traffic crashes; and


WHEREAS, City Council recognizes the regulation of cellular telephone use by motor vehicle drivers is a public safety and quality of life issue in our community.


The City Council of the City of Marco Island supports State legislation banning the use of cellular telephones by motor vehicle drivers in Florida.
