

ORDINANCE 03- 04

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SMALL SCALE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT PETITION SSCPA-03-02, ASSIGNING "COMMUNITY COMMERCIAL" FUTURE LAND USE DESIGNATION FOR A 0.54 ACRE PARCEL OF LAND DESCRIBED AS THE EAST 300 FEET OF TRACT "C", (MORAN'S BARGE MARINA), MARCO BEACH UNIT 17; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island adopted a Comprehensive Plan pursuant to Chapter 163, Part II of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 163.3187(1)c outlines the process and criteria for small scale comprehensive plan amendments, which may occur without regard to statutory limits on the frequency of consideration of amendments to the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, William Morris, Esq. representing Maureen Moran, Inc., has requested a small scale comprehensive plan amendment to change the designation on the Future Land Use Map for the subject property from "Preservation/Conservation" to "Community Commercial"; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing, the Planning Board has considered the recommendation of staff and the public input and has recommended by a vote of 4 to 1, with 1 abstention, that the request be denied; and

WHEREAS, after considering the recommendation of the Planning Board and staff, following a public hearing on the subject, and providing the petitioner an opportunity to speak, the City Council has determined that the petition should be granted.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Petition SSCPA-03-02 is hereby granted, amending the Future Land Use Map designation for the subject property from "Preservation/Conservation" to "Community Commercial", more particularly described as the east 300 feet of Tract "C", Marco Beach Unit 17, Marco Island, Florida.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the earliest date permitted under Section 163.3189, Florida Statutes.




