

MARCO ISLAND CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 03-14

APPROVING AN OFF-PREMISE GROUND DIRECTORY SIGN WITHIN THE MARCO LAKE BUSINESS DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island has adopted Ordinance 02-11 which established signage regulations; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.C.2 of Ordinance 02-11 allows for off-premise ground directory sign after consideration of the Marco Island Planning Board and approval of the Marco Island City Council; and

WHEREAS, Diane Chestnut, on behalf of business owners within the Marco Lake Business District, has submitted a request for an off-premise ground directory sign; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island Planning Board considered the request at their March 7, 2003 meeting and voted 6-0 to recommend that the City Council approve the request as presented; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council has considered the advisability of an off-premise ground directory sign within the Marco Lake Business District as presented by Diane Chestnut, and has found as a matter of fact that satisfactory provision and arrangement have been made concerning all applicable matters required by said regulations and in accordance with Section Four of Ordinance 02-11.

WHEREAS, all interested parties have been given opportunity to be heard by this Board in public meeting assembled, and the Board having considered all matters presented;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND CITY COUNCIL that:


The request submitted by Diane Chestnut, on behalf of the business owners within the Marco Lake Business District, as shown on the attached Exhibit "A" is hereby approved.


This Resolution adopted after motion, second, and majority vote.


