

MARCO ISLAND CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 03- 57

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND ESTABLISH AN EROSION CONTROL LINE FOR APPROXIMATELY 0.87 MILES OF SHORELINE ON HIDEAWAY BEACH, MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the shoreline located between 0 and 3600 feet southwest of the entrance to Collier Bay and between 7800 and 8500 feet southwest of the entrance to Collier Bay, within the City of Marco Island, Collier County, has continued to erode, with the result that there is often no dry beach in front of seawalls; and

WHEREAS, maintaining sand in front of existing seawalls will provide improved shore protection and recreational benefits for the residents and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the proposed erosion control project, consisting of replacing temporary T-groins with permanent T-groin structures, construction of a jetty at the entrance to Collier Bay, and additional beach fill, is consistent with the recommendations of the County's Big Marco Pass Inlet Management Study; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to delineate the boundary between the upland properties and State-owned submerged land from the southern limit of the Hideaway Beach Erosion Control Project to the entrance to Collier Bay, not presently included in the existing FDEP Erosion Control Line File 0788.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Council requests that the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund establish an Erosion Control Line for approximately 0.87 miles of shoreline on Hideaway Beach, Marco Island.


Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


