
WHEREAS, the unwavering volunteer and civic support the Marco Island Charter Middle School receives demonstrates the importance the community places on the continued success of the school; and


WHEREAS, the need for permanent facilities for the Marco Island Charter Middle School is vital to its continued success and for the safety of its students.


