

ORDINANCE NO. 01-03

**AN ORDINANCE TO ASSESS TWO DOLLARS AS A COURT COST FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE EDUCATION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 938, Florida Statutes provides for mandatory court costs in addition to any fine or other penalty against every person convicted for violation of a state penal or criminal statute or convicted for violation of a municipal or county ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 938.15, Florida Statutes provides that in addition to costs provided for in Section 938.01, municipalities and counties may assess an additional \$2 for expenditures for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses including basic recruit training, for the respective officers and employing agency's support personnel, provided such education degree programs and training courses are approved by the employing agency administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island deems it in the best interest of the City to encourage criminal justice education programs and to partially fund these programs through the assessment of an additional \$2 to any fine or other penalty.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that

**Section 1.** In addition to costs provided for in Section 938.01, Florida Statutes, the City of Marco Island hereby assesses an additional \$2 for expenditures for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses.

**Section 2.** If any word, phrase, clause, subsection, or section of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of any remaining portions of this ordinance.


**Section 3.** That all sections or parts of sections of all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**Section 4.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Marco Island City Council on second reading and Public Hearing.

Passed in open and regular session through roll call vote by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2001.


