

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-18**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ENACTMENT OF A  
ONE-HALF PERCENT LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
DISCRETIONARY SALES TAX.**

WHEREAS, these are significant transportation infrastructure needs in Collier County; and

WHEREAS, the One-Half Percent Local Government Infrastructure Discretionary Sales Surtax is a revenue source available to fund needed infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners will consider adoption of an ordinance to enact a one-half percent sales tax and call for a referendum election on November 6, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners intends to commit proceeds from the one-half percent sales tax for road improvements; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Marco Island will benefit by the allocation of a share of the one-half percent sales tax revenue for infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the one-half percent sales tax provides a means by which residents and tourist share the cost of required infrastructure improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA that the Marco Island City Council supports the Board of County Commissioners in the enactment of the One-Half Percent Local Government Infrastructure Discretionary Sales Surtax.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Marco Island City Council encourages the Collier County electorate to support the enactment of the one-half percent sales surtax.
