

RESOLUTION NO. 00-46

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE IMPOSITION AND COLLECTION OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS TO FUND THE COST OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROVIDING A SPECIAL BENEFIT TO LOCAL AREAS WITHIN THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 99-1 authorizes the imposition and collection of special assessments to fund the cost of capital improvements providing a special benefit to local areas within the City; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 99-1 provides that City Council shall adopt an Annual Assessment Resolution during its budget adoption process for each fiscal year in which assessments will be imposed, and to approve the assessment roll for such fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 99-21 authorized Phase I Sidewalk Improvement District, and Resolution 99-27 approved the assessment rolls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1: This Resolution is adopted pursuant to the Assessment Ordinance, Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of law.

SECTION 2: The assessment roll as provided in the attached Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby adopted as a part of the budget process for fiscal year 2000-2001.


SECTION 4: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


