A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX FUNDING FOR THE MARCO ISLAND FILM FESTIVAL

Whereas, twenty-eight percent of the tourist development taxes are generated from Marco Island; and

Whereas, it is the policy of Collier County to designate certain portions of the tourist development tax funds to support the promotion of cultural events and tourism, including off-season events; and

Whereas, the first Marco Island Film Festival was held on Marco Island in 1998; and

Whereas, the Marco Island Film Festival generates tourism revenue to Collier County and offers to the people of Collier County a unique cultural experience; and

Whereas, the Marco Island Film Festival has submitted a request for \$100,000 to the Tourist Development Council for funding in 1999.


