

**RESOLUTION NO. 99- 11**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE COLLIER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RETAIN THE CURRENT SITE FOR THE COLLIER COUNTY LANDFILL.**

WHEREAS, the Collier County Board of Commissioners is currently evaluating the relocation of the County Landfill from its current site located south of Golden Gate Estates near Route 951; and

WHEREAS, a study committee was appointed by the Collier County Board of Commissioners to recommend site locations, one of which is identified as Site L, located four miles east of the City of Naples well fields that supply the bulk of water to the City of Naples; and

WHEREAS, the current landfill has the capacity for at least another thirty to fifty additional years; and


WHEREAS, the relocation of the landfill to a new site will increase the costs of solid waste disposal to the residents of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Marco Island City Council, in council duly assembled,

- Section 1. The City Council respectfully requests the Collier County Board of Commissioners to maintain and expand the landfill at its current site.
- Section 2. The City Council endorses the utilization of techniques of landfill management to address odor control problems at the current landfill.
- Section 3. The City Council supports the appointment of a study committee by the Collier County Board of Commissioners to determine techniques of landfill management that may reduce or eliminate odor while expanding the landfill capacity.
