**A RESOLUTION TO EXPRESS APPRECIATION TO THE  
NORTH NAPLES FIRE CONTROL AND RESCUE  
DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island was desirous of State Certified Fire Training for its newly employed Public Safety Officers to expand upon the knowledge and skills relating to fire prevention and fire suppression in order to protect the health and safety of Marco Island residents; and
