**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND  
TO COMMEND LEE COUNTY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE AND ITS  
EMPLOYEES FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING RESPONSE TO  
HURRICANE GEORGES**

*Whereas*, the people of Marco Island were required to implement emergency procedures to respond to the approach of Hurricane Georges, classified as a Category Two Hurricane; and

*Whereas*, high winds throughout the day caused continuous power disruptions to many areas of the City; and

*Whereas*, Lee County Electric Cooperative assigned personnel to Marco Island to respond to the power outages caused by Hurricane Georges; and

*Whereas*, Lee County Electric Cooperative employees continued to work throughout the day during very adverse weather conditions to restore electrical power to Island residents; and

*Whereas*, the superb efforts of the employees of Lee County Electric Cooperative significantly enhanced the safety and wellbeing of the many residents who remained on Marco Island during the storm event, and limited damage to personal property because of the quick response.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that Lee County Electric Cooperative be commended for their hurricane preparedness and responsiveness to the people of Marco Island.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the employees of Lee County Electric Cooperative be commended for their dedicated effort to restore electrical power to the community despite severely adverse weather conditions, and for their high regard for the safety and welfare of their utility customers, the people and businesses of Marco Island.
