RESOLUTION NO. 98-7

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND WATER AND SEWER COMMISSION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island is provided water and sewer services by the Florida Water Services Company; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Marco Island has no control over Florida Water Services Company's rate making policy; and

WHEREAS, many residents believe current rates are too high; and

WHEREAS, residents believe future rate increases will cause them to have to leave Marco Island.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida:

SECTION 1: That a city water and sewer commission be appointed to study the feasibility of the City of Marco Island acquiring the assets and facilities of the Marco Island Subsidiary of the Florida Water Services Company. It is further resolved that the commission shall have 11 members, seven appointed by the City Council, and four board members of the Fair Water Rate Committee.


SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


