

RESOLUTION NO. 12-05

A RESOLUTION APPROVING PETITION FV-12-01. GRANTING A VARIANCE TO THE FLOOD ORDINANCE WHICH IS FOUND IN SECTION 26-31 OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND CODE OF ORDINANCES RESPECTIVELY; PERMITTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RESTROOM AND A DUNEWALK OVER “BOARDWALK” AT HIDEAWAY BEACH, AND SUCH PROPERTY IS DESCRIBED HEREIN AS EXHIBIT “A”.

WHEREAS, Section 26-31 of the (“Code”) establishes flood zone controls and parameters for building and structural construction; and

WHEREAS, Petition FV-12-01, is a request for variance from the requirements prescribed in flood zone ordinance, Section 26-31 of the Code; and

WHEREAS, John Barto petitioner and president of the Hideaway Beach Association has petitioned the City for this variance to allow for the construction of a restroom and boardwalk improvements at Hideaway Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island Planning Board, following an advertised public hearing held on February 3rd, 2012, considered public input, the recommendation of staff, and the standards and guidelines of Section 26-31 of the Code to consider the advisability of such a petition and voted 7 to 0 to recommend that the Marco Island City Council, acting as the Board of Zoning Appeals approve the requested variance; and

WHEREAS, as part of its deliberation, the Planning Board found that the petition is consistent with the City’s Comprehensive Plan, and in particular, the flood ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the requested improvement subject to this variance will benefit persons with disabilities, families and all other citizens, and are otherwise in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council is acting as the Board of Zoning Appeals; and

WHEREAS, after considering the recommendation of the of the Planning Board and after providing the petitioner, staff, and the public an opportunity to present testimony and evidence, the City Council, as the Board of Zoning Appeals, finds as a matter of fact that satisfactory provision and arrangement have been made concerning all applicable matters required by City Ordinance, Section 26-31 of the Code; and

WHEREAS, all interested parties have been given opportunity to be heard by this Board in a public hearing assembled, and the Board has considered all matters presented.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Marco Island City Council, that:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this resolution by this reference.


Section 2. Approval. Variance Petition FV-12-01, filed by John Barto, petitioner and President for the Hideaway Beach Association, with respect to the property legally described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made part hereof, is hereby granted to allow for a variance from the Flood Zone Ordinance as provided by Section 26-31 of the Code, to allow for the construction of a restroom facility and dune walkover ("boardwalk") and supporting infrastructure in the approximate locations as depicted in Exhibit "B".

Section 3. Recordation Required. This Resolution relating to Petition Number FV-12-01 shall be recorded in the minutes of this Board and filed with the Marco Island City Clerk's Office.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.



RANGE 26, CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA**


